POLAND: Walesa's Victory

Solidarity chief Walesa's narrow margin of victory in the balloting yesterday for chairmanship of the union probably will require him to pay more attention to the views of the organization's militants.

Walesa received just 55 percent of the vote, with his three militant rivals splitting the other valid ballots. Early in the congress, his supporters had been predicting that Walesa would win an overwhelming victory, with as much as 80 percent of the votes. Although Walesa's immediate reaction was to warn those who voted against him that "they should not stand too much in my way," this appears to be an emotional response rather than a realistic appraisal of his future relations with the militants.

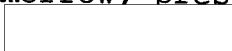

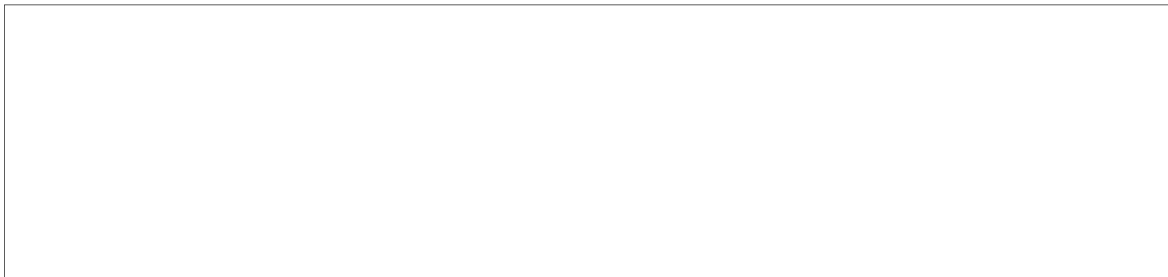


a two-day party Central Committee session is scheduled to begin tomorrow, presumably to assess the results of the congress.

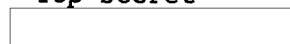

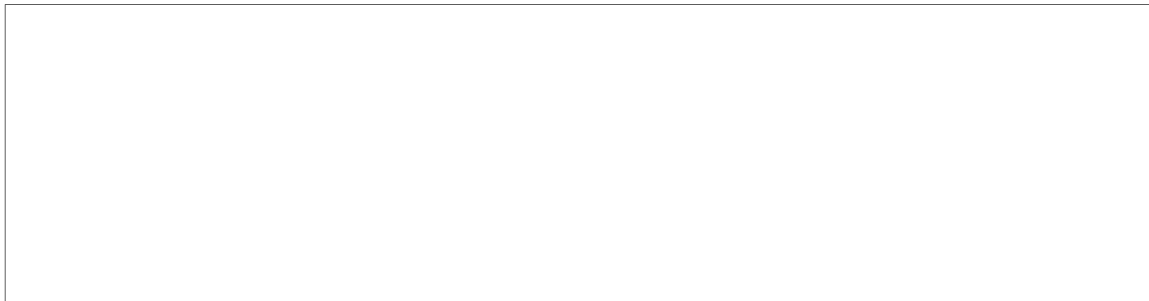
President dos Santos is in Libya, where he probably is putting the finishing touches on an aid request

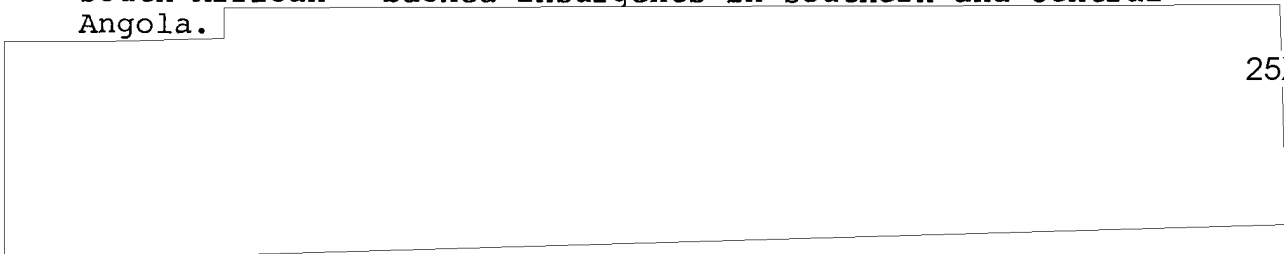
