The following items were discussed by the Community Representatives at the 22 September warning meeting.

- I. <u>Warning</u> -- There were no warning items this time in the East Asia area.
- II. Procedural Alert -- The Upcoming North Korean Winter Training Cycle: There is need for especially thorough intelligence coverage and analysis of these upcoming exercises, particularly in view of the very wide differences of interpretation which still exist as to just what form these exercises will take, and whether they will cloak actual aggressive intent.
