1. On April 15, 1941, as a result of the approved
M.I.D. memorandum (G-2/10580-492) letters were sent by the
Secretary of War to the various Departments and independent
agencies of the Government requesting designation of repre-
sentatives to study the above subject. Various meetings

and agencies as a result of which a final report has been
approved by those representatives and is now in process of
being presented to their respective Departments and agencies
for final approval and action necessary to effect that
