April, 1920 - letter from IOCD introducing Mr. Gaston Escoube, representative of firm going abroad. Letter to M/A, Vienna, re Mr. Escoube, requesting assistance.

February, 1922 - Maj. Churchill wrote Mr. Swift, requesting renewal of contact. Letter from Mr. Swift, expressing willingness to cooperate, but advising Mr. Holmes, his assistant, will call before instructions are sent representatives. Mr. Holmes called in March.
