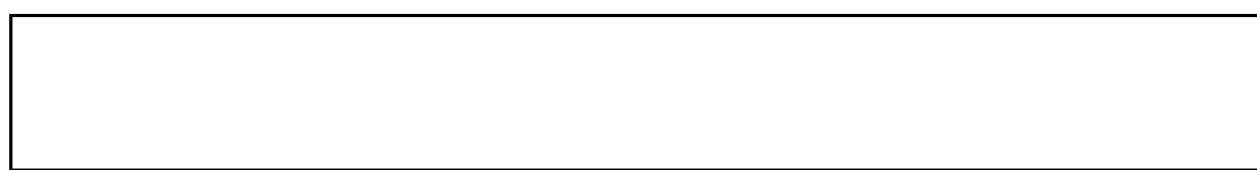

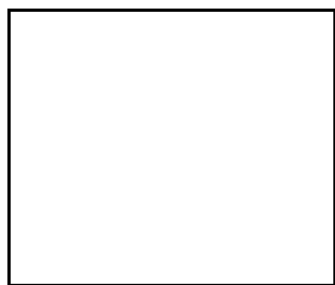

b. Mr. Fisher gave a brief progress report on the Combined Federal Campaign. By Directorate, the percentages of dollar goals achieved to date are:
