The Security Analysis Group has determined that the Covert Action Information Bulletin, a publication which is dedicated to exposing CIA activities and personnel throughout the world, has announced in their October 1979 issue that they have established an organization known as The Intelligence Research and Information Services, Incorporated. According to CAIB, this organization is eligible for the receipt of tax-deductible contributions for the support of the Covert Action Information Bulletin. (U)
