20 December 1946, provide in section 5(a) that delegation of authority to advertise may be exercised only by heads of departments, although the Comptroller General indicated in an opinion found in 28 Comp. Gen. 305 that the subordinate official to whom such basic authority is delegated may assign to others the administrative duties necessary to accomplish the advertising authorized.
