1. Reference is made to your memorandum of 14 October 1949, requesting our determination as to whether subject employee is entitled to the quarters allowance, applicable to her post of assignment, from this Agency. Assuming that Subject is entitled to quarters allowance you also request our determination as to whether she is entitled to a quarters allowance on the basis of with family or without family.

2. Confirming our conversation of this date I am returning her with your memorandum of 14 October and Dispatch No. [REDACTED] to which is attached Subject's claim for quarters allowance, Form 33-22, in duplicate. The Dispatch raises the question whether the granting of a quarters allowance to Subject on either the with family or without family basis would be in conflict with the regulations issued by the FEC. It would appear that living quarters are available in that area to individuals having ratings below Grade CAF-12, and that their occupying living quarters together may operate to relieve the Army of responsibility of granting any allowances. This matter should be clarified by contacting the field.
