**SUBJECT : 1966 Campaign of the International Service Agencies**

1. This memorandum transmits for your signature a letter to The Honorable Orville L. Freeman.

2. The proposed letter is in reply to a letter to you from Secretary Freeman who is serving again this year as National Federal Chairman for the campaign of the International Service Agencies. 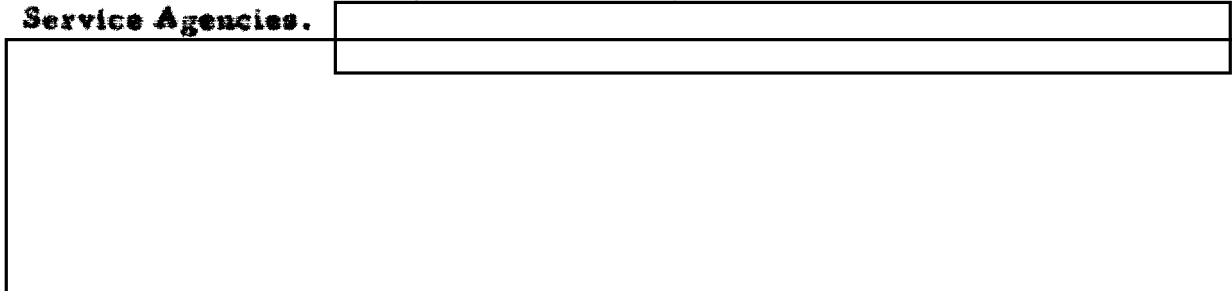
