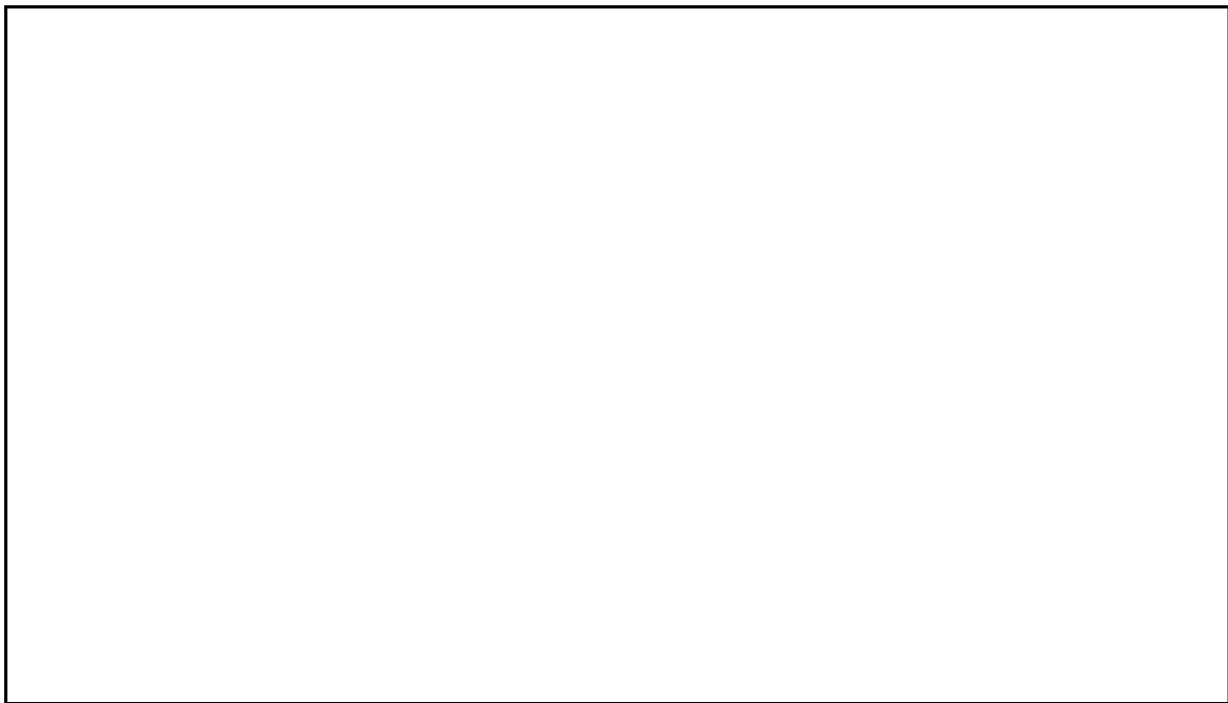

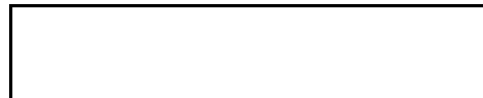

SUBJECT : Emergency Power for Agency Headquarters Facilities

The seriousness of a power failure accompanied by the deficiencies noted in our emergency power system cannot be overstated.
