Although only one nomination is customary, should you feel that two individuals in your organization are equally eligible to receive the Award, the Committee will consider both. Nominations should be prepared and submitted in accordance with instructions contained in the enclosed announcement.

We urge you to participate in this worthwhile endeavor to give public recognition and honor to individuals who are making outstanding contributions in the field of management.
