MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Personnel

Emmett :

During your absence, [redacted] I met with Col. White on his initiative to discuss the importance of our outplacement program and the necessity to improve it. Col. White intends to have a meeting on his return from leave shortly after 1 December with Messrs. FitzGerald, Karamessines, [redacted] Bannerman, yourself, and any others needed to discuss this subject more fully. As a first step, I think it is essential that we have a good inventory of what we are presently doing in detail and some reading of our successes and inadequacies. Mr. Bannerman would like to have you present this material to him on Wednesday, 23 November. [redacted] will give you a time if you will call her.

One comment that Col. White made which may be of use to you is that he felt that all too frequently we were including as successful outplacements [redacted]

[redacted] He recognized the difficulties including the desire of individuals not to leave the Washington area, excessive salary demands, expectations of more or equivalent status, etc. There are no doubt many others and you may wish to have a good listing of these difficulties with some thoughts on how they can be overcome. I am available to discuss this further with you if it would be helpful in preparing your material.
