STAT You may want to see the attached exit interview report on [redacted] formerly in Africa Division. I understand you and Mr. Helms are familiar with his case. He's a neighbor of Bill Moyers who, I'm told, helped him get a job at Housing.

In his exit interview, Wilson had some criticisms of CIA--low grades; slow promotions; and inadequate career planning, especially for non-official cover personnel--but said it's the "finest agency in the Government" and indicated that he <sup>was</sup> leaving purely for economic reasons.
