Dave Phillips assigned to write the history of the 1954 Guatemala operation. Within days after Lou and I talked, he suffered a heart attack. The prognosis is guarded.

As you know, there are two proposals on their way to the DCI which, singly or together, will have a major impact on the history program. A decision to make histories more accessible internally and externally will impose a challenging work load on the staff, particularly its chief. He plans personally to push internal dissemination and has always assigned himself the task of seeing to the re-writing, santitizing, coordinating, and releasing the U-2 history.

Component histories continue to wander in, and they are edited, typed, and covered by the staff.

During July, there was nothing to report on space, on integrating with archives. No responses were received on an intelligence museum collection.
