

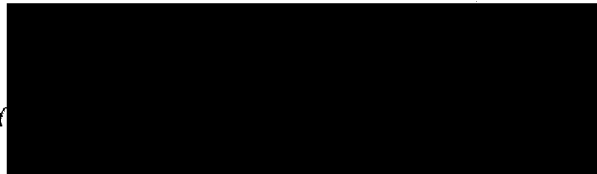

SUBJECT : Potential GAO Audit of Agency Programs

I can see no special restrictions which would need to be placed on GAO auditors reviewing the operations of the Office of Joint Computer Support beyond the normal clearance and classification requirements that apply to the Agency's business. The data stored and processed on our computers, for the most part, is placed in our "custody" for such functions. Therefore, access to computer data bases would have to be with the approval of the "owner" of such data; for example, the Office of Personnel, Office of Finance, Office of Medical Services, DDI, DDO, etc.
