I. Major Activities During the Past Week:

A. Support to OTR

STATINTL PREVMAN - A system for preventive maintenance for the Office of Training. The modifications which the customer requested to be made to the OL/HEB maintenance system appear to be simple to add. CARTDEV - The line smoothing program which was obtained from the Engineering Topographic Laboratory has been modified and delivered to the customer. The program will support the digitization of the 200 mile fishing limit for the Law of the Sea Project. This effort involved about 180 person hours and 550 lines of code. [REDACTED]

STATINTL OCRDIR - Automation of the OCR directories. We have provided support to OCR/FEPAC personnel in the preparation of a preliminary (XEROX 1200) listing of Chinese directory data. This listing was produced in response to a request from a National Security Council customer. A copy of this listing was also forwarded to Secretary of State Vance prior to his visit to China.
