

The Biographic Register, largest and probably best known of the four Registers, had its genesis in C.I.G. Directive No. 16 of 1 November 1946, "Plans for Coordination of Biographic Intelligence." C.I.G. 16 assigned responsibility for reporting biographic data, producing biographic intelligence and maintaining supporting files on various categories of personalities among the agencies represented on the Intelligence Advisory Board.
