- 1. State Dept. paper presents accurately the reluctance of Allies to back drastic actions against Soviet Union now.

The President, of course, has already alluded to the Marshall Plan in his initial speech on Poland. It need not be seen as a "bail-out" of Polish economy (cf. "Cons" under II. A. 5.) if it is clearly linked to pursuit of economic (and political?) reforms.
