CLAT SUPPORT FOR THZVELECTORAL PROCESS IS LIKELY TO HAVE GREATER IMPACT ON GOVERNMENTS OUTSIDE OF EL SALVADOR, INVITING ELECTION OBSERVERS FROM CLAT AND THE WCL IS AN EXCELLENT IDEA.
