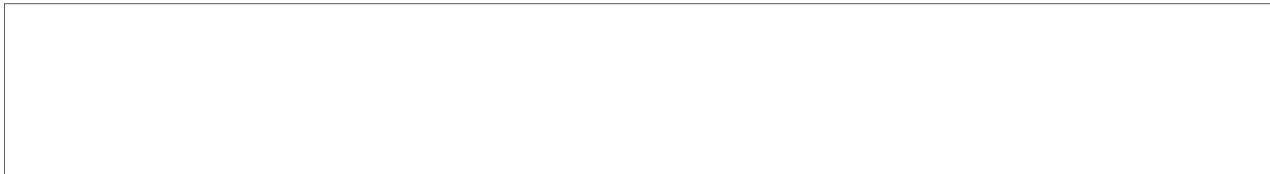

1. The following items are on your agenda for tomorrow morning's meeting.

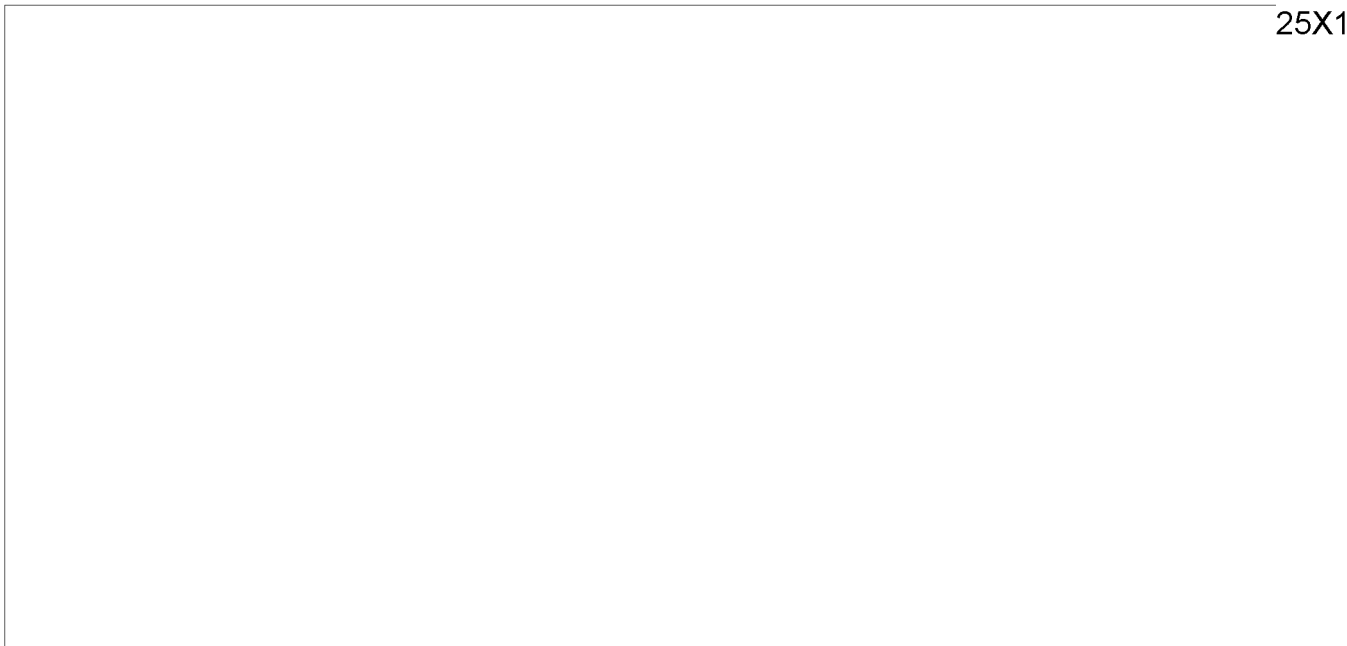
-- Versailles and NATO Summits. Secretary Haig will be prepared to offer you his views on the events in Europe of the last ten days.
