SUBJECT: Topic for Discussion at DCI Breakfast Meeting
with Secretary Haig on 15 June 1982.

NAMIBIA-ANGOLA

1. Africa Division has been advised by the Department of State that, at the DCI-Secretary of State Breakfast Meeting on Tuesday, 15 June 1982, Secretary of State Alexander Haig intends to brief the Director on the current status of the Namibia independence negotiations. The Secretary will also discuss current U.S. relations with the National Union for the Total Independence of Angola (UNITA) of Dr. Jonas Savimbi, as well as UNITA's need for foreign assistance other than that provided by the South Africans.
