## Honduran Air Force Capabilities

The Honduran Air Force is the best in Central America, but  its fifteen Super Mystere fighters are woefully obsolete  Furthermore, since the Air Force began its own pilot training program in 1974, it has not been able to provide enough trained pilots to meet requirements. Finally, a shortage of qualified mechanics and technicians would limit the capability for sustained operations.  The Air Force is based at four locations, Tegucigalpa, Comayagua, San Pedro Sula, and La Cieba. The airfields have adequate facilities to support the aircraft normally deployed there.	25X1 25X1 25X1
