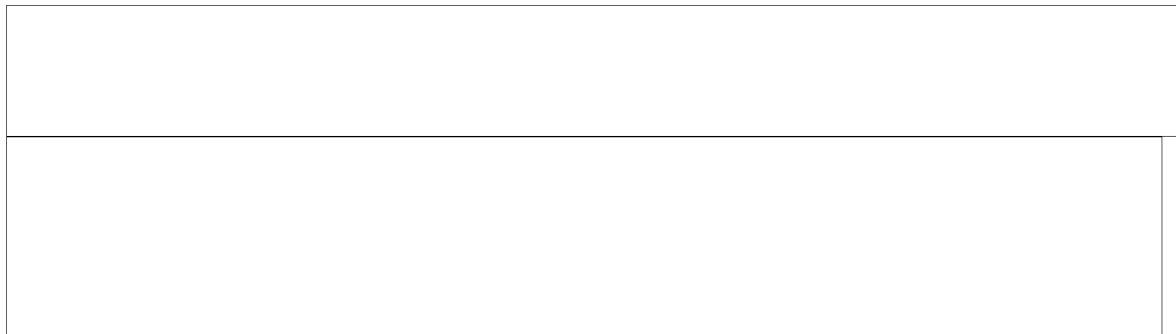
light of your discussion last week and Weinberger's strong anti-Khomeini sentiment, you may wish to discuss this further with Carlucci.

Meanwhile, the NIO for Latin America today held his monthly warning meeting, which spent considerable time discussing the future of Argentina as well as developments in Central America. [redacted]

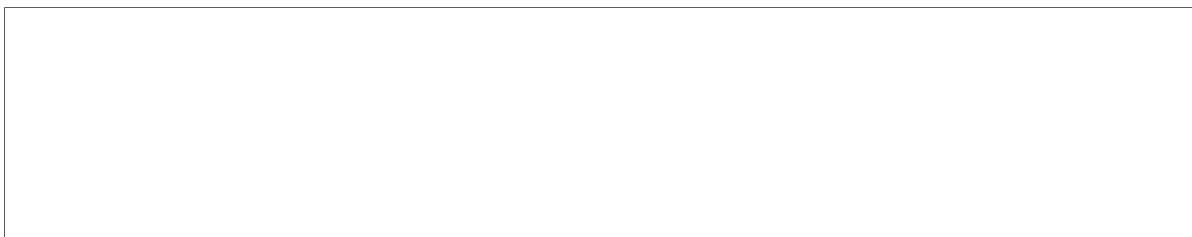

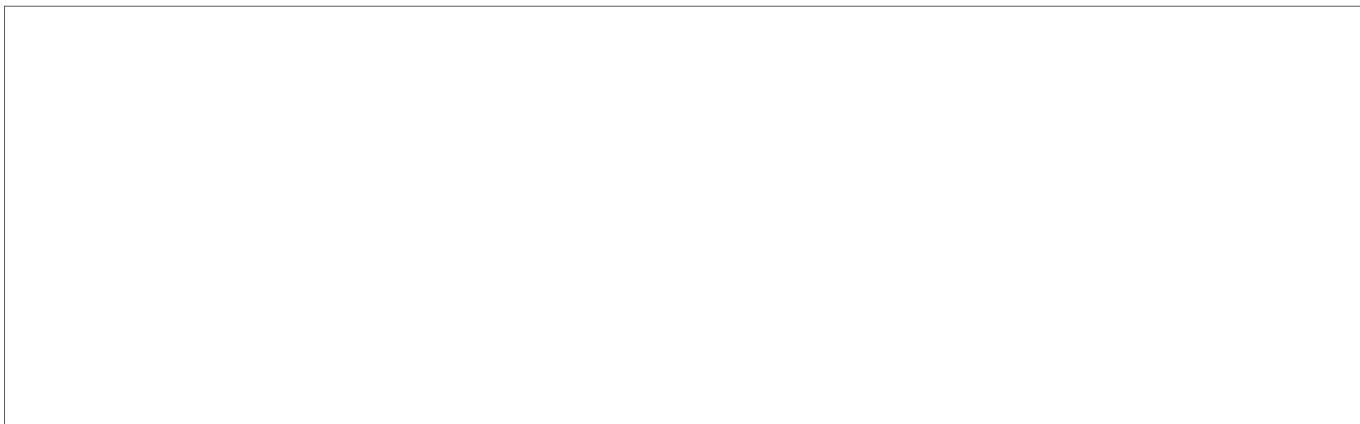
