1. (CONFIDENTIAL - ENTIRE TEXT)

2. IN RESPONSE TO REFTEL B PARAGRAPHS 3,4 AND 5, DEPARTMENT HAS UNDERTAKEN A PRELIMINARY REVIEW OF POSSIBILITIES OF PROVIDING ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE TO GOH. PENDING THE PASSAGE OF THE CBI THERE ARE NO IMMEDIATE POSSIBILITIES OFADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE TO HONDURAS. THE COUNTRY'S DETERIORATING ECONOMIC-SITUATION WILL, HOWEVER, PLACE IT IN A POSITION TO REQUEST ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE SHOULD UNEARMARKED CBI FUNDS BE AVAILABLE. IN THE MEDIUM TERM WE ARE SEEKING INCREASED ASSISTANCE FOR CARIBBEAN SUGAR PRODUCERS AFFECTED BY THE RECENT QUOTAS.

3. A CAP ON ASSISTANCE TO EL SALVADOR UNDER THE CBI SUPPLEMENTAL WAS AGREED UPON IN THE HOUSE

FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE. IF A CAP IS MAINTAINED IN THE FINAL BILL, FUNDS ORIGINALLY PROGRAMMED FOR EL SALVADOR MAY BE AVAILABLE FOR REALLOCATION TO OTHER CBI BENEFICIARIES. ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE TO HONDURAS WOULD BE REVIEWED CONCURRENTLY WITH AN ANALYSIS OF THE URGENT NEEDS AND REQUIREMENTS OF OTHER POTENTIAL CBI BENEFICIARIES.

- 4. THE PROGRAMMING OF AN ADDITIONAL 20-25 MILLION DOLS. IN 1982 ESF FUNDS TO HONDURAS IS NOT POSSIBLE AS THERE ARE NO UNEARMARKED FUNDS AVAILABLE.
- 5. THE DISTRIBUTION OF SUGAR QUOTAS WAS BASED ON A SIMPLE, IMPARTIAL FORMULA, CONSIDERING EACH COUNTRY'S AVERAGE LEVEL OF ANNUAL SUGAR EXPORTS TO THE U.S. OVER THE PERIOD 1975-81 (EXCLUDING ITS HIGHEST AND LOWEST PERFORMANCE YEARS). IT WAS DECIDED AT THE CABINET LEVEL THAT ONLY SUCH AN IMPARTIAL FORMULA IS DEFENSIBLE IN VIEW OF BOTH OUR FORMAL OBLIGATIONS IN THE GATT AND THE ADMINISTRATION'S GENERAL TRADE POLICY OBJECTIVES. SOME COUNTRIES, LIKE HONDURAS, WHICH HAVE ONLY RECENTLY INCREASED THEIR PRODUCTION AND EXPORTS ARE UNDENIABLY DISADVANTAGED BY THIS FORMULA.
