In addition to any areas you had in mind, the following are listed as areas that would be of interest to Senator Nunn during his visit now scheduled for the morning of 27 September 1982:

- A. Soviet Defense Spending-a brief perspective and prediction
- B. Soviet Military Capabilities-strengths and weaknesses-(including views on technological sophistication of Soviet weapon systems).
- C. Soviet Economy-strengths and weaknesses
- D. Soviet Satellites-strengths and weaknesses
- E. Soviet Leadership Succession
- F. Soviet Strategic Nuclear Forces to include modernization, capabilities, accuracy, hardness, and [REDACTED]
- G. Soviet Record in Arms Control Compliance
