**MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN, UNAUTHORIZED DISCLOSURES INVESTIGATIONS
SUBCOMMITTEE, SECOT.**

SUBJECT: Unauthorized Disclosures Damage Assessment (U)

Reference: Chairman, UDIS memorandum, TCS-022-82, 26 May 1982, subject as above.

1. (S/SI/TK) The Office of Security (OS), Defense Intelligence Agency has reviewed the listing of those media accounts of unauthorized disclosures of information revealing intelligence sources and methods, provided as an attachment to reference. DIA has not investigated any of the media accounts listed, and, therefore, is unable to comment on damage to sources and methods resulting from these disclosures. The CIA and NSA, those agencies with primary responsibility for imagery and SIGINT collection, would be best able to determine the damage resulting from the disclosures.

2. (S/NOFORN/WNINTEL) OS has investigated a [] Associated Press article by [] (enclosure) also dealing with the Falkland Islands situation. It was determined that a variety of DIA products, such as briefings for the Chairman, Joint Chiefs of Staff, a briefing for the House Appropriations Committee, DIA Situation Reports, and DIA Briefing Cables, all from the period 11-13 May 1982, were possible sources for the []. In addition, the article also contained classified information derived from a [] a number of U.S. 25X6 DIA 25X1 addresses including the White House, CIA, the Departments of State and Energy, the U.S. representative to the United Nations and selected recipients in the Department of Defense.

3. (S/SI/TK) All of the DIA products cited above, as well as the [] message, were classified Top Secret Codeword and contained classified information derived from sensitive imagery and [] products furnished to DIA by [] CIA and NSA. 25X1

[] Continued disclosures of such information may be diplomatically damaging and could in fact result in a [] 25X6

[] However, the specific damage to sources and methods from this disclosure would best be addressed by [] and the CIA; 25X1 DIA the originators of the information.
