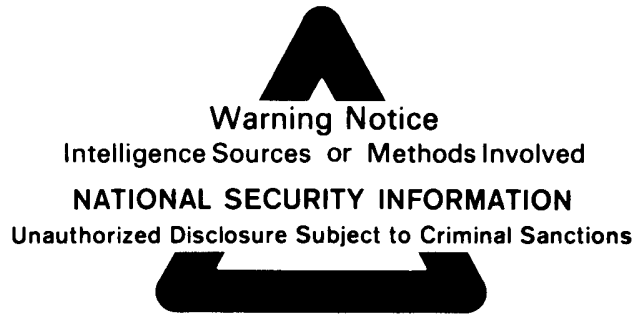

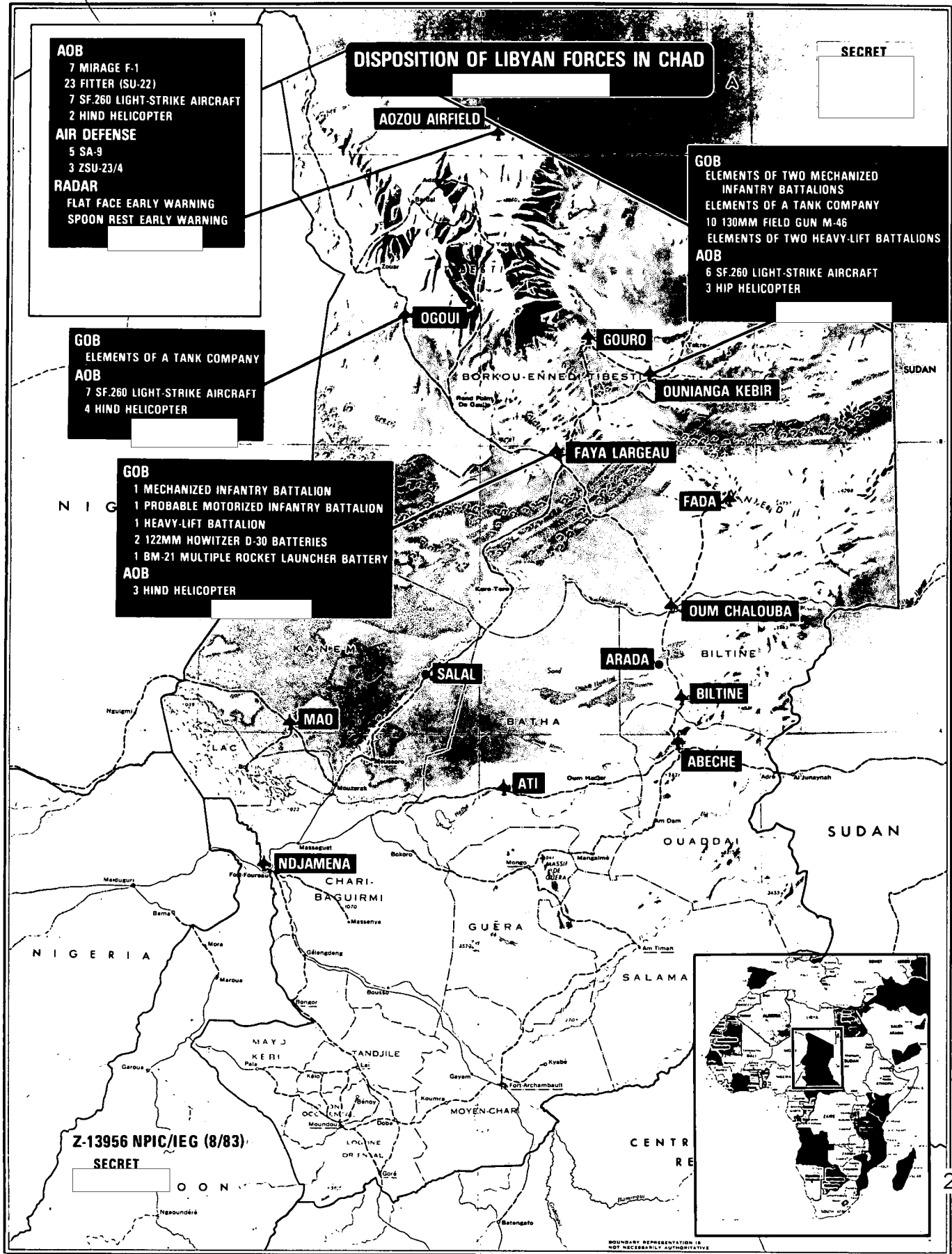

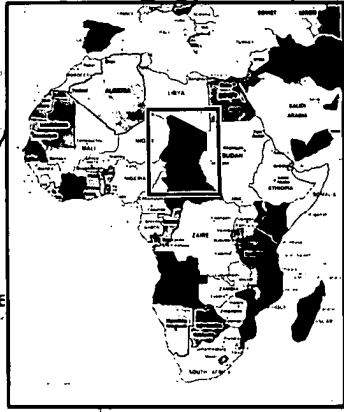

1. SIGNIFICANCE: THE DISPOSITION OF LIBYAN GROUND AND AIR FORCES IN NORTHERN CHAD [REDACTED] IS DEPICTED ON THIS MAP GRAPHIC. (SWN) 25X1

2. REMARKS: THE CONFLICT BETWEEN LIBYAN/LIBYAN-BACKED DISSIDENT FORCES AND CHADIAN GOVERNMENT FORCES ESCALATED WITH THE INTRODUCTION OF LIBYAN MECHANIZED AND MOTORIZED INFANTRY UNITS IN LATE JULY. PRIOR TO THAT TIME ONLY LIBYAN LOGISTICAL RESUPPLY TRANSPORT FLIGHTS TO LIBYAN-BACKED DISSIDENT-HELD TOWNS IN NORTHERN CHAD COULD [REDACTED] SINCE LATE JULY, LIBYAN GROUND FORCE UNITS HAVE PUSHED AS FAR SOUTH AS FAYA LARGEAU AND ARE CURRENTLY 420 NM NORTHEAST OF THE CAPITAL, NDJAMENA. 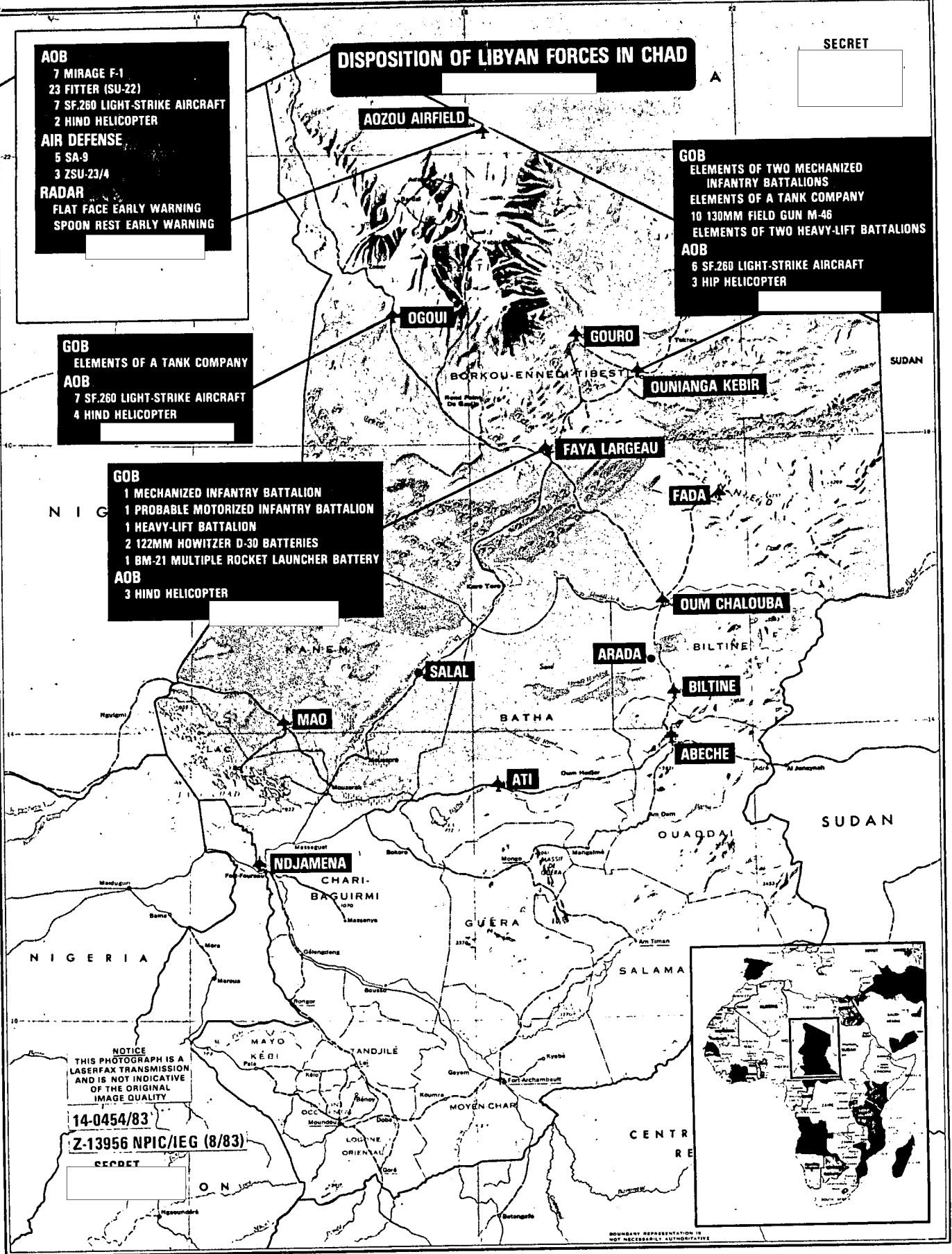

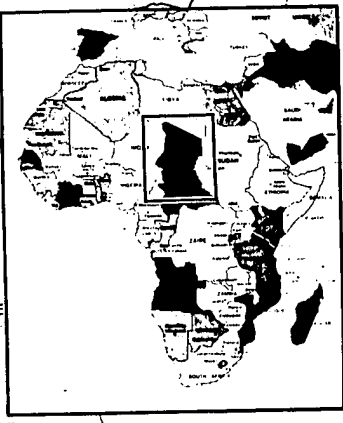
