HUNGARY - WEST GERMANY: Kadar in Bonn
Hungarian party leader Kadar is in Bonn for the first time since 1977 for talks with Chancellor Schmidt and other West German leaders on Hungary's current problems and on East-West relations. Comment: Kadar, who is deeply concerned over Budapest's credit situation, is likely to stress that progress on reforms will require enough Western credits
to allow Budapest to cover its debt service without further tightening its austerity measures.
Schmidt regards Kadar as a trusted interlocutor between East and West and probably will attach great importance to Kadar's appraisal of the current situation in Poland following his meeting last week with Premier Jaruzelski.
