SOUTH AFRICA - NAMIBIA: Military and Diplomatic Moves

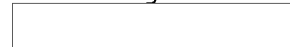

South Africa, while strengthening its forces in northern Namibia and southern Angola, also is questioning the good faith of the South-West Africa People's Organization in negotiations and is emphasizing its objections to the Cuban presence in Angola.

Foreign Minister Botha charged this week in Windhoek that SWAPO had ordered political murders and sabotage in Namibia during the implementation of a settlement. The South Africans have shown Western diplomats alleged captured documents outlining such plans.



Pretoria also is publicizing Angolan insurgent leader Savimbi's claims that an 8,500-man Cuban force is attacking his units in central and southern Angola.

Comment: Although Pretoria's military and diplomatic moves may be aimed at applying pressure on the Angolans to negotiate, they also prepare domestic and Western opinion for a large-scale military strike into Angola if the talks on Namibia are not concluded by Pretoria's deadline of 15 August.

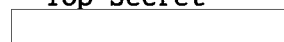
