SUBJECT: Use of Questionnaire in Training Evaluation

1. I have passed your questionnaire and explanation around to the powers that be in the DRD and all are suitably impressed. We have discussed the possibility of adopting this throughout FBIS in evaluating TDY'ers and have concluded that: a) It may not work in all FBIS bureaus since the monitor supervisor system is unique to Panama; b) Sending this to all bureaus now that very few TDY'ers are going out could easily result in the whole thing being filed away and forgotten; c) In view of the amount of paperwork in which bureaus are already involved, we do not feel now is the time to be generating more.

2. What I will do is pass this package on to [redacted] who is going to Okinawa as chief editor this summer. I will also retain a copy here and discuss it with any senior editors or deputy chiefs departing for field bureaus that may be involved in training TDY's. In the unlikely event of a trainee being assigned to a bureau other than Panama or Okinawa for a TDY, I will pouch a copy of your system, presenting it as a proposal the bureau may want to adopt in whole or part for the training program.
