the Agency must posses and foster the in-house capability to explore certain ideas in their raw state in order that they may be presented for NRO consideration with greater confidence and substantiation on our part.

- 6. It may be advanced that BPAM has divined that OSP activities form an integral part of the MtP and hence, we should obtain our "mad money" or funds for such idea making from the Untional Deconnaissance Programs. While such a contention is for the most part correct, it cannot apply universally without serious restrictions on the imagination and ingenuity which has made CIA a pacemaker in the reconnaissance field.
- 7. One should recognize readily that it is difficult to justify or sell an idea without some data fleehed about it. We do not suggest that the Agency underwrite our feasibility studies or andoratory efforts, the last should do that; what we do submit, Lowever, is that the Agency should permit us the funding to organize our presentations with supporting data collected from limited contractor efforts.
- 0. We have attached an itemization of the areas in which we seek Agency flanacial support. We have included the Itek effort of has been obligated. We have further reduced our carly budget subraission from upon the accumption that the MTP will fund a portion of our planned efforts as part of the National Program.
- 9. It is requested that you approve the reprogramming of DD/83T funds in the sum of to meet our FY-66 proposed activities.
