1. This memorandum is in response to your request for assistance from our Agency to procure equipment and provide support for your Advanced Medium Range Air-to-Air Missile (AMRAAM) Program.

2. After many discussions and meetings with both our technical and procurement personnel, we can provide you with the following:

- a. A single copy, on magnetic tape, of the TADS software (you will need to lease the VM operating system from its vendor before we can give you our local modifications).
- b. Limited consulting support from both our Systems and Applications Programming areas.
- c. Assistance in the procurement of hardware; given that the funds are transferred to this Agency, and the hardware is delivered directly from the vendor(s) to your facility.

Unfortunately, we cannot assist you in the installation of the required hardware.

3. TADS is a very complex system requiring local monitoring and modification by Systems and Applications programming support groups for each particular TADS installation. I suggest that you procure this local support to install, maintain, and enhance TADS from private industry.
