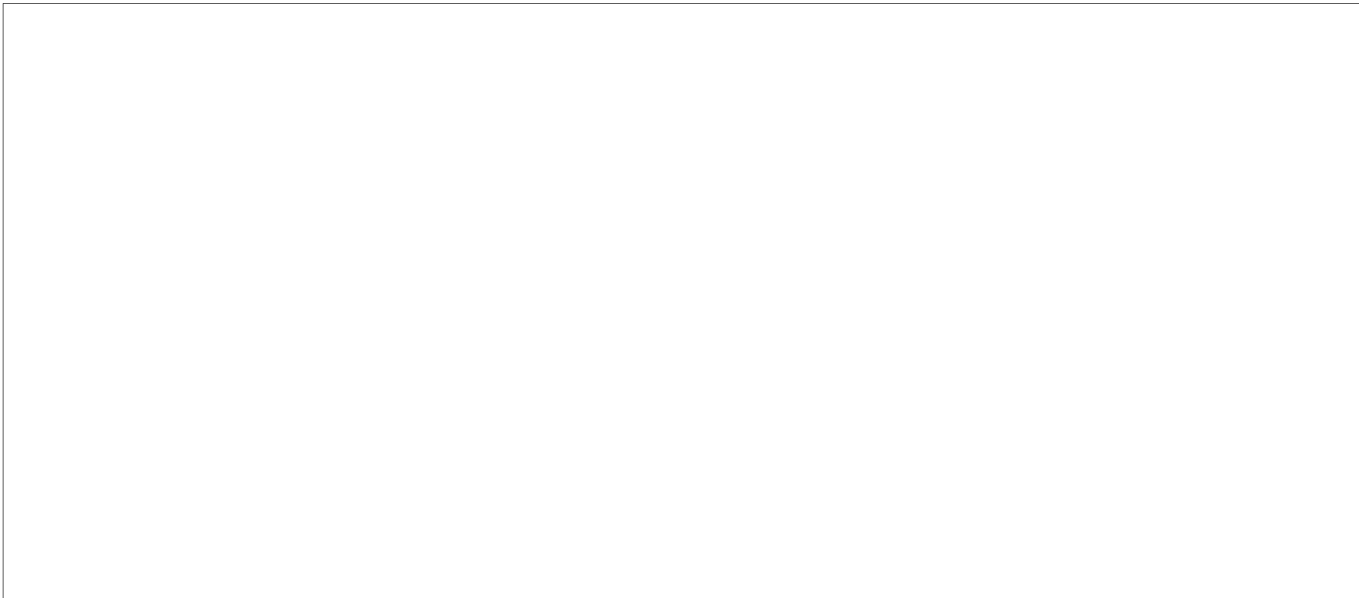

c. A concerted effort was made to order as many Delta Data terminals as possible against the Agency Requirements Contract before the established date (26 February 1983) for price increases. A total of 297 terminals (and associated equipment) were ordered on 25 February with a dollar value of \$1,936,252. The savings realized by placing the orders prior to the price increase is \$74,398.

d. The Agency shuttle buses are being repainted.
