2. Background:

a. The Collection Plan on technology transfer at Tab A was developed with the active participation and concurrence of the Technology Transfer Intelligence Committee (TTIC) and appropriate agencies and departments.

b. The Plan will also be supplemented by a Collection Support Brief prepared by the TTIC which elaborates on priority requirements at the CONFIDENTIAL level and provides detailed source screening guides and source follow-up questions for field collectors. [redacted]
