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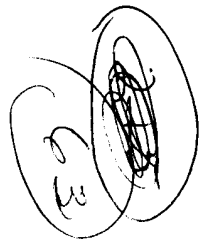

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1. PLEASE DESTROY THE ORIGINAL MINIBOARD AND MINIBOARD NOTES PROVIDED WITH Z-19644/84. (SWN)

2. CONTINUING ANALYSIS OF [REDACTED] IMAGERY OF SAYQAL AIRFIELD (BE [REDACTED] REVEALS THAT AT LEAST ONE AIRCRAFT PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED AS A MIG-27 FLOGGER D, IS IN FACT, A MIG-23 FLOGGER F/H. THE OTHER FOUR AIRCRAFT PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED AS FLOGGER D ARE PROBABLY ALSO FLOGGER F/H. AN EXTENSIVE ANALYSIS OF SAYQAL AIRFIELD ON [REDACTED] REVEALED A PREVIOUSLY UNDISCERNED ENGINE AIR INTAKE BOUNDARY LAYER SPLITTER PLATE ON ONE OF THE FIVE AIRCRAFT PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED AS A FLOGGER D. 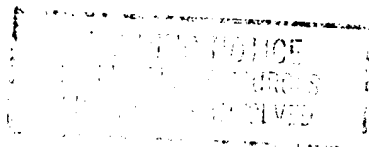
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
