Advised Mr. Casey to withhold a decision on APEX until he is much more familiar with the situation and until he has consulted with the new Deputy Secretary of Defense and the new Deputy Director of Central Intelligence.  Expressed the opinion that it is unlikely Mr. Casey will be inclined to give up any of the responsibilities the DCI now has. He advised Mr. Casey that he should be briefed on the compartmented collection systems by the program managers before reaching any conclusions regarding these	25X1
