1. The information contained in the referent memorandum is appreciated. The details in paragraph two will assist the Building Planning Staff (BPS) in planning for consolidations and future space projections with the Office of Security. The information in paragraphs four and five, although not requested, includes details which will be helpful in the future.

2. BPS is currently assisting in planning for space essential to EFS and OGP. This was mentioned to [redacted] and [redacted] of the OS Staff. Our discussion brought forth the fact that the Logistics Services Division, OL was already involved in space negotiations with OS and BPS concerning a move plan which was in no way a BPS responsibility. The cases of EFS and OGP are being considered in a separate context by BPS. OGP was not discussed with [redacted] in relation to the Office of Security and the [redacted] Buildings. 25X1A9a

3. The possibility of relocating elements of EFS/OS was brought up during considerations of placing elements of the Office of Security together for greater efficiency in general management and supervision. If the Physical Security Division could be brought together, this would enhance many of its activities. The suggestion of possibly consolidating it in the [redacted] Building did not appear to be feasible or practical to [redacted]. At this point we talked about other locations, such as the second floor of the [redacted] Building, as being more compatible and effective working areas. This discussion took place as a part of a review to determine the possibility of consolidating any Agency component which is now dispersed in a number of buildings. 25X1A6a

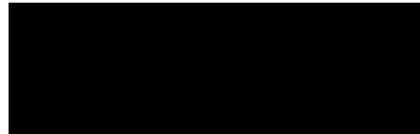

The above information will clarify your records and assist as supporting future joint considerations for improving the space situation of the Office of Security. Any major move to consolidate OS elements into a single location would probably be at least two years away. However, EPS will continue to search for possible interim OS Divisional consolidations while making space projections and planning.



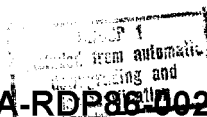
