The largest design firms in the U.S. squeezed record billings out of 1970's tight-fisted construction market, according to ENGINEERING NEWS-RECORD's seventh annual survey. Fewer architectural and engineering names made this year's roster than in 1969 because more design-contractors crowded them out.


Two-thirds of the leading designers billed owners for more work in 1970. Several of the largest design firms racked up increases of 100% or more over their 1969 billings. And the 442 leading designers billed \$1.9 billion last year, a substantial increase from 1969's \$1.7 billion garnered by 460 leading design firms.

The maximum billing volume of the leading designers peaked to a new record as two firms billed \$30 million or more in 1970. The minimum billing volume also rose, to over \$1.3 million, up from \$1.2 million a year ago.







erparts. More design-contractors made the list this year, 58 compared to 40 firms in 1969, but only one out of three that made the list both years increased their volume.

**Top 10 designers shuffled.** The 10

leading architectural and engineering firms were well shuffled in 1970. Chas. T. Main, Inc. leads the list for the first time, moving up from its No. 3 slot in 1969 to push Sargent & Lundy back to No. 2.

# Billings in '70

Michael Baker, Jr., Inc. moved up two notches to No. 3 and Skidmore, Owings & Merrill holds down the No. 4 slot for the second consecutive year.

Two newcomers joined 1970's 10 largest architectural and engineering

firms. Tippets-Abbott-McCarthy-Stratton (TAMS) is back among the top 10 after a five-year absence. TAMS jumped to No. 5 from the 12th position it held in 1969. And Gibbs & Hill, Inc. slipped into the No. 9 spot.

Howard, Needles, Tammen & Bergendoff slipped down to No. 6 from its No. 2 peg a year ago. Gilbert Assoc., Inc., DeLeuw, Cather & Co., and Louis

Burger, Inc. were slightly shuffled in their rankings to make room for Gibbs & Hill.

**New top design-constructor.** The 58 top design-contractors accounted for over \$16.5 million in 1970 awards. Their total was greatly boosted by Boise Cascade Engineering and Construction Group that broke the \$2-billion mark for the first time in the history of The ENR 500.

The 10 largest design-contractors had few shake-ups in their listing this year. Boise Cascade jumped to the No. 1 slot for the first time. Bechtel Corp. and The Ralph M. Parsons Co. edged back to Nos. 2 and 3 respectively. Kaiser Engineers Division, Brown & Root and The Rust Engineering Co. kept the same positions they occupied in 1969. But Stearns-Roger Corp. leapt from No. 16 to oust The M.W. Kellogg Co. from the No. 7 peg.

Fluor Corp. jumped five slots to No. 8, pushing Arthur McKee & Co. down to No. 10. The Lummus Co. again ranks No. 9 this year.

Twenty design-contractors joined The ENR 500 this year that did not make the roster in 1969.



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

Two out of five work abroad. Two out of five leading design-contractors did foreign work for part of their 1970 operations. Billings for work outside the U.S. increased for architectural and engineering firms, but contract awards for design-contractors dipped.

Two out of three of the 58 top design-contractors won contracts in foreign countries in 1970, a smaller percentage than in 1969 when three out of four design-contractors signed up jobs abroad.

More design-contractors joined the ENR 500 this year, but their \$4-billion-plus in contracts for overseas projects failed to match last year's \$4.4 billion foreign total for only 29 firms.

Kaiser Engineers Division again had the highest awards from foreign work, but its \$546.2 million in 1970 fell way below the \$705.6 million it reported a

year ago. Boise Cascade Engineering and Construction Group came close to matching Kaiser's foreign total as its awards jumped to \$505.4 million.

biliings of the leading architectural and engineering firms jumped 10% to \$170.3 million. Consulting engineers billed the largest portion, \$69.6 million, a 19% increase over a year ago. Engineers-architects billed the second highest sum, whereas they had the largest share of overseas billings in 1969. Architects upped their foreign billings 40% to \$2.1 million while architects-engineers billed 3% less for jobs abroad than in 1969.

While 280 of the leading designers re-

port they do take on work abroad, only two out of three (64) units to foreign projects in 1970. Many of those that did have jobs overseas last year saw their billings drop, especially designers that billed less than \$2.5 million.

Consulting engineers had the best growth record in foreign billings; two had increases for every consultant with a drop in foreign billings. About one-half of the leading architects-engineers and engineers-architects increased their overseas billings. But more architects

The increase stems from both the complexity of projects that require total environmental and sociological planning. These factors offset the impact of fewer new construction starts in 1970 than in 1969, so that only one out of three leading designers saw their billings squeezed by last year's tight money conditions.

But those firms with higher billings raised the average billings for all lead-

ing design firms by 13.5% to \$4.2 million per firm. This sustained a good average rate of growth that saw average billings per firm climb 13.1% in 1969.

Consulting engineers fared the best in 1970 of any type of design organization. Four out of five consultants billed owners for more work last year than 1969. Architects had the second best record; three out of four increased their billings last year. For architects-engineers and engineers-architects, two

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Many cut staffs. Almost half of the leading design firms have smaller design staffs now than a year ago, based on company reported figures including professionals and technicians, but excluding all clerical and accounting personnel.

Staff reductions were most prevalent among design firms doing less than \$5 million in annual billings. Yet nearly one-half of the designers with 1970

billings over \$5 million reduced staff in

Architects' staffs suffered the most widespread reductions, with more architectural firms reducing staff than increasing it. Architects-engineers followed close behind with one firm cutting back for each firm that showed an increase. Consulting engineers and engineers-architects were more moderate with staff reductions and only about 40% of them reported cut-backs during the past 12 months.



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Despite recent staff reductions, the ratio of professionals to staff remains at 50% for every type of design organization.

Average 1970 billings per staff member increased across the board. But increases are exaggerated because billings are for 1970 while staff size is current, so that widespread staff reductions are not fairly reflected in billings.

For architects, the average billings per staff member rose 19% to \$45,456. Architects-engineers saw their average billings to staff ratio leap 11% and consulting engineers and engineers-architects paced a 9% jump over a year ago.

Soils engineers billed an average \$130,000 per staff member, up 8% from 1969.

**More city planners.** More than half of the leading designers do city or regional planning, a slight increase from 1969. Transportation planning is done by more than one out of three design firms. Each year the popularity of these types of planning along with pollution control and mass transit studies grows among The ENR 500. While environmental and sociological planning is relatively new dimension in the design field, it is fast becoming an indispensable aspect.

outside firms for some of their mechanical and electrical work.

Use of outside firms diminishes for combined design firms. Only one out of seven architects-engineers subcontract their mechanical and electrical work, and the ratio drops to 1:8 for subcontracted structural work. Engineers-architects employ only a minimal number of outside firms.

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loans or temporary staff transfers.

Over 3,300 design firms were surveyed and 40% responded. The response by large firms was close to 100% because of numerous follow-ups. Only 12 leading designers were reluctant to give their billings—about half as many as refused in 1969. These firms are included, ranked by ENR estimates of billings based on company-reported staff sizes.

Design-contractors are ranked by contract volume, including design-only contracts valued at estimated erected value of such projects.
