MEMORANDUM FOR: Deputy Director for Support

SUBJECT: Status of Space

1. We have examined in depth both the current and future space requirements of the Agency's departmental activities with the intent, ultimately, to consider consolidation of overt activities at Langley.

2. Projections of personnel and technological requirements to the 1975-80

~~and the Headquarters and Printing Services Buildings.~~ If authorization were granted by Congress to proceed with construction plans in 1967, a target date for completion of one or more new buildings at Langley would approximate 1976.

3. With a legitimate regard, however, for the President's hardline on non-essential construction together with an appreciation of the impact upon the Agency's space needs of relatively rapid advances in the technological field, we have re-examined our space requirements in an attempt to satisfy only the most *and these needs which cannot be met through the expedient of leasing office space* pressing needs. These center in those special purpose activities which have *continued* plans to adopt the advanced techniques and equipment necessary to the electronic mechanization of information systems. Considerable savings in money and space can be realized if these special purpose activities were consolidated in

a separate building constructed solely to this end. Without significant increases in personnel, we would require a net of about [redacted] construction to house such activities as OCS, Signal Center, TSD, etc. An estimated target date for completion would approximate 1971 if congressional authorization to proceed were given by June 1967. *Estimated cost would be approximately 17.5 million dollars.*

4. Without resorting to new construction and to handle the initial stages of the adaptation to more sophisticated electronic mechanisation we have GSA approval to acquire [redacted] square feet of additional space in the Rosslyn [redacted] *To be occupied by units now located at Langley, will then* The space will enable programmed expansion of computer and communications

activities centered in OCS, RID, [redacted], OSP and Signal Center. The [redacted] 25X9 square feet will account for programmed expansion only through FY 67. An additional [redacted] square feet for these activities above has been planned through 1975-80.

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
