- 1. We have examined in depth both the current and future space requirements of the Agency's departmental activities with the intent, ultimately, to consider consolidation of overt activities at Langley.
  - 2. Projections of personnel and technological requirements to the 1975-80

and the Headquarters and Printing Services Buildings. If authorisation were granted by Congress to proceed with construction plans in 1967, a target date for completion of one or more new buildings at Langley would approximate 1976.

3.
