SUBJECT: Decisions on IG Survey on Entry-On-Duty Processing

1. Attached are the DCI's and my decisions on the IG's recommendations on the Agency's entry-on-duty processing system. You will note that we have deferred action on Recommendations 9 a and b until 1 January 1984. The Office of Personnel believes that recent innovations, some of which were based on suggestions in the IG's survey, will make the system substantially more efficient. We are willing to wait until the end of the year to see if these changes have had the desired results.

2. At that time, however, I have asked the IG to take another brief look at EOD processing to assist us in making a final decision on Recommendations 9 a and b. I would also appreciate your feeding into that process by providing me, through the IG, a progress report on actions completed on the other recommendations. You should aim for 31 December.

3. The DCI and I remain concerned about our limited headway in recruiting CTs. While this IG report did not focus on CTs in particular, I would also like you to touch base with [redacted] Task Force and include in your December progress report a picture of where we stand in filling up our CT pipeline.
