- What is your position re two "watch dog" groups as recommended by the Commission?
- What "internal reorganization" of CIA is necessary to have CIA "produce greater emphasis on certain of its basic statutory functions"?
- Wherein is CIA failing in its basic function of producing intelligence on the USSR? and why
- Where has CIA failed in "greater concentration on the collection of information about technological and military developments and plans of 'our primary target' the Soviet bloc?
- Why has CIA not been "bold" enough and what limits its "freedom of action" that causes "deficiencies in this Country's knowledge of Communist plans"?
- Why has CIA been "too conservative" and lacked taking "vigorous and timely action in the field" of collecting intelligence?
- Why has CIA been subordinated in its intelligence collection by "diplomacy" or State Dept. viewpoints--why does CIA fear or give way to "diplomatic or even protocol complications"?
- Why is CIA so administered it cannot fully and effectively carry out the authority the law gives it and efficiently use the organization it "has so soundly conceived"?
- What is the reason for the "desk level" attitude that "stifles initiative and action in the collection of intelligence"?
- Why is the Soviet intelligence more bold, more willing to accept calculated political and diplomatic risks to get results
