I regret not being able to attend your talk but greatly appreciate your taking the time from a very busy schedule. I'm sure you will be well received, as you always are on the Hill.

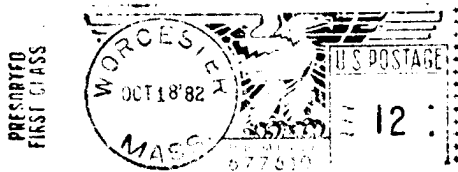
