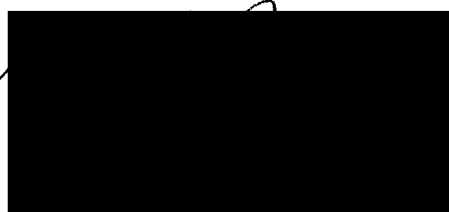

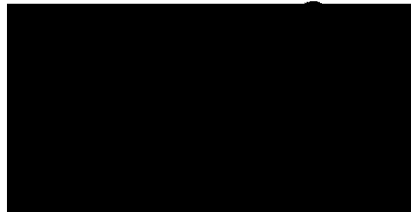


Dear Mr. [REDACTED]
