

2. As we have considerably more lead time to study the CIP submissions prior to the time the Review Group meets, we should be able to detect any situations that would be of particular concern to the DCI. As I go through the material (I received an 8-inch stack of Air Force data this morning) I will be able to keep you informed on the highlights of the Departments proposals for each unit and/or activity.  will keep me informed on any major changes that will be proposed by DIA as a result of their in-house review which goes on from now until the end of May.

The extent to which we can get a preview of the Communist picture in toto or for various functional groupings of activity will depend on how quickly I get data from the CCP (Gerry is arranging to get me the Subelement data), the NRP and the CIA. In general there are more areas of functional likeness in the CCP and CIA programs than in the other two.
