

I have read those portions of the 1984 National Strategy for Prevention of Drug Abuse and Drug Trafficking that relate to the work of the Intelligence Community, and find these portions to be worded in an appropriate and clear fashion. In collecting, processing and analyzing narcotics intelligence, the Intelligence Community operates under the authority of the Executive Order 12333, and the draft appears consistent with all aspects of that Order.

The Intelligence Community has made substantial gains over the past few years in producing foreign intelligence on narcotics, and additional gains are anticipated. I have reviewed the draft of the 1984 Federal Strategy for Prevention of Drug Abuse and Drug Trafficking. As you know, Executive Order 12333 authorizes the Intelligence Community, in accordance with law, to collect, produce and disseminate intelligence on the foreign aspects of narcotics production and trafficking. My review of the draft confirms that the Intelligence Community's role in contributing to the international objectives of the Federal Strategy is presented at a level of detail appropriate for a document reflecting national policy guidance.
