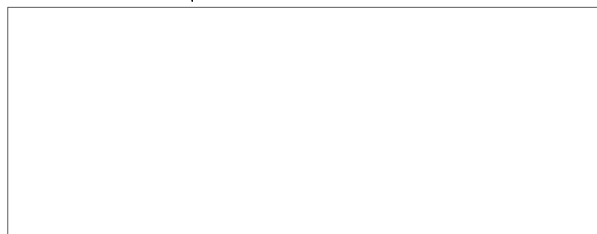



I am pleased to forward, for your review and comment, the draft working paper which will update the 1982 Federal Strategy for Prevention of Drug Abuse and Drug Trafficking.

The paper reflects the results of the implementation reviews and the suggestions provided by the involved agencies. One common observation was that the President's 1982 Strategy is working well and the revised Strategy should reinforce, rather than change the current approach.

The enclosed draft working paper has not been approved as official policy. It should be treated as sensitive and must not be released outside the designated review channels.
