SUBJECT: London Summit Public Diplomacy Coordination

In its meeting of April 17 co-chaired by the White House Summit Group (WHSG), Michael K. Deaver and Robert C. McFarlane confirmed the TDY appointment of Ambassador James M. Rentschler as the President's Public Diplomacy Coordinator for the London Economic Summit and other activities related to the President's European trip in June. As was the case during preparations for the Williamsburg Summit last year, Ambassador Rentschler and his small inter-agency team will report to the WHSG, working closely with Undersecretary Wallis' Sherpa group and other key elements of your agencies and departments as appropriate. Ambassador Rentschler is currently located in Room 389 of the Old Executive Office Building (telephone: 395-3937).
