- 1. DMA has recently completed a programming adjustment to the FY 84 mapping/charting program. As of 7 May 1984, the adjustment will result in a 7-sheet shortfall in your requirement area. The shortfall affects production of new JOG-Gs in the USSR (5) and maintenance production of city graphics in North Korea (2).
