SUBJECT: FEMA Support to CIA [redacted]

1. This note is in response to your verbal request on 15 August that I look into what the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) can do for CIA in non-nuclear war situations. [redacted]

2. On the basis of discussions, primarily in the Directorate of Administration (DA), the following areas where FEMA might help have been identified:

-- training on select hazards and emergency procedures,

-- use of FEMA sites [redacted]

[redacted] for CIA conferences and training sessions (security permitting), and

-- attendance for CIA personnel at the National Fire Academy. [redacted]

3. In order to determine whether FEMA might be helpful in these or other areas, I will arrange for briefings by FEMA for interested Agency components. I have also requested copies of the course catalog for FEMA's Emergency Management Institute for distribution in the DA. [redacted]
